1. Indian Coast Guard invites applications in the prescribed format as given at Annexure-I from eligible Indian citizens for filling up the following vacancies by Direct Recruitment:-

(c) **Eligibility Criteria:**

**Educational Qualification/Experience.**

(i) Matriculation pass from a recognized Board or equivalent.

(ii) Must possess valid driving license for both heavy and light Motor Vehicles.

(iii) Should have at least two years' experience in driving Motor Vehicles, and

(iv) Knowledge of motor mechanism (should be able to remove minor defects in vehicles).

(c) **Eligibility Criteria:****Essential:-**

- (i) Matriculation pass from a recognized Board or equivalent.
- (ii) Should be physically fit and capable of performing strenuous duties.

**Note:-** The physical fitness shall be tested as per the following physical standards:-

(i) Height without Shoes – 165Cms. Provided that a concession of 2.5 Cms in height shall be allowed for members of the Scheduled Tribes and candidates of hilly areas.

(ii) Chest (unexpanded) – 81.5 Cms

(iii) Chest (on expansion) – 85 Cms

(iv) Weight – 50 Kg(Min)

(v) Endurance Test:

(aa) Carrying a man weighing 63.5 Kgs by fireman lift up to a distance of 183 meters within 96 seconds.

(ab) Clearing 2.7 meters wide ditch by landing on both feet (long jump).

(ac) Climbing 3 meters vertical rope by hands and feet.

(d) **Age Limit and Relaxations.**

(i) 18-27 years

(ii) Relaxable for Government Servants upto five years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government.

2. **How to Apply.** Application form should be filled either in English or Hindi as per the prescribed format given at Annexure-I. The application with duly affixed self attested colour photograph should be accompanied by Xerox copies of the documents listed below, duly self attested with name and date. No original certificates are to be forwarded alongwith the application form:-

- (a) Valid Photo ID proof (As mentioned in application).
- (b) Matriculation or equivalent mark sheet and certificate.

- (c) Relevant educational qualification Certificate/marks sheet as per the essential eligibility criteria of the respective post.
- (d) Latest Category certificate (SC/ST/OBC) for reserved category candidates.
- (e) Experience certificate (as applicable)
- (f) NOC from the employer for presently serving in any Govt organization (If applicable).
- (g) Two latest passport size colour photographs.

**Note:**

- (i) The date of issue of all the above documents is to be on or before to closing date of application i.e. **07 Oct 2024**.
  - (ii) The candidates belongs to SC category are to produce category certificate as per prescribed format under Govt of India for appointment to the post of Civilian Motor Transport Driver (Ordinary Grade) as per the format placed at **Annexure- II**.
  - (iii) No original certificates are to be forwarded alongwith the application form.
  - (iv) If the Government employee is not able to obtain NOC from the employer within the stipulated time, he should forward any valid document proof or undertaking w.r.t. age relaxation alongwith the application for considering the eligibility for issuance of admit card only. However, NOC should be produced at the time of document verification prior written examination.

4. **Mode of Selection.**

- (a) **Scrutiny of Applications.** All applications received from the candidates will be scrutinized subject to the eligibility criteria and necessary documents and the admit cards will be issued to the shortlisted candidates for document verification & appearing in the written examination.

(b) **Document Verification.** All the shortlisted candidates will undergo document verification prior appearing in the written examination. Candidates will be required to bring their original documents and self - attested Xerox copies (02 sets) of the same as per the directives / instructions given in their admit cards.

(c) **Written Examination.** All the shortlisted candidates will undergo written examination on the basis of educational qualifications prescribed for the post. The written examination will be pen- paper based and one hour duration. The Question Paper (bilingual) for written examination will consists of 80 objective type questions with one mark for each correct answer and there will be no negative marking.

(d) Merit list will be prepared strictly based on merit position as per marks obtained in written examination and will be published on the Indian Coast Guard website alongwith necessary instructions. If two candidates score same marks in written examination, then the candidate older in age will be higher in merit.

5. Questions on Numerical aptitude, Mental Ability/ Reasoning, General English and General Awareness will be matriculate standard. The pattern of written examination is as follows:-

**Note:-** The candidate applied to the post of **Civilian Motor Transport Driver(Ordinary Grade), Fork Lift Operator, Sheet Metal Worker and Carpenter** will also undergo a **Trade Test** on qualifying the written examination which is qualifying in nature whereas the selection of candidate applied to the post of **Fireman** is subject to qualifying the **Physical Fitness and Endurance Test**.

6. **Important Instructions to Candidates:-**

(a) Before applying for the post, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills the eligibility and other norms mentioned in the advertisement. Furnishing of wrong / false information will lead to disqualification and ICG will not be responsible for any consequence of furnishing of such wrong / false information.

(v) Photocopies of self attested documents not found enclosed.

(e) Candidates working in Govt departments are to forward their application through proper channel only before the due date of receipt of application alongwith NOC issued by concerned authority.

(f) SC/ST candidates are entitled for 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail / bus fare by Shortest route as per Govt rules and the same will be reimbursed at the venue of written examination on submission of tickets.
